The Town of Edisto Beach, SC recently mailed the postcard below to their seasonal residents, reminding them to respond to the 2020 Census and to be sure they have recorded themselves at the primary address they live and sleep at most of the time. This postcard campaign reached approximately 1,900 households.

Every month since April 1st, United Way of Laurens County has hosted a raffle for residents who have completed their census questionnaire. What was initially planned as a one-time promotion has become a monthly event to encourage participation in the 2020 Census. Monthly raffle prizes have included a Ninja blender, Summer Activity Pack, and an Instant Pot. 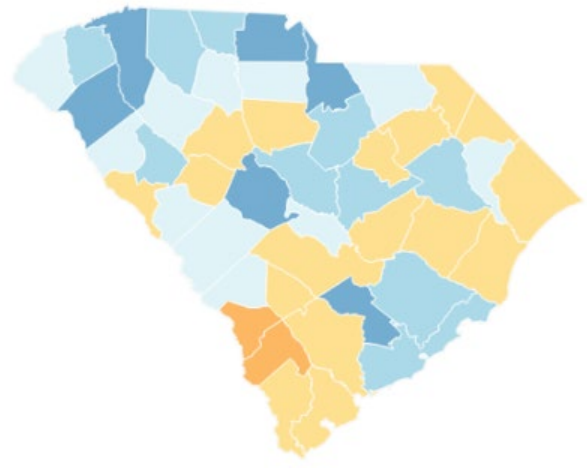
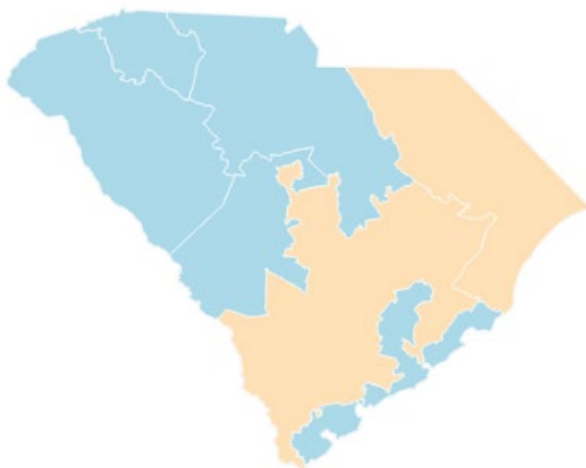
